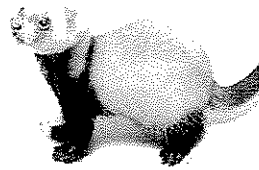

Public Health Law requires all dogs, cats, and ferrets be vaccinated by 4 months of age.
